Q: responsible, nice, sporty, careful

BABYSITTER: look after the baby, like children, change the diapers, give a bath

Q: calm, patient

GARDENING: mow the lawn, water the flowers, trim the plants or the hedges

Q: patient, hard working, sporty, like working outdoors (extérieur)

SHOP ASSISTANT: sell, tidy up the clothes, give advice to customers, bagging or wrapping purchases (achats)

RUNNING ERRANDS FOR ELDERLY PERSONS: do the shopping, bring mail, help to walk, do the housework

CARRY THE SHOPPING BAGS: go to the greengrocer's, stock shopping in the cupboards

CAT SITTER

CAR WASHER: wash the car, clean, Hoover, clean the window sill (pare brise)

PAPER ROUND: ride a bike very well and very fast, deliver the newspaper, be punctual and wake up early

WAITER/helping in a fast food restaurant: make sandwiches, take phone orders, toss salads

CLEANING UP IN A SPORT HALL: know how to use the cleaning products, Hoover, sweep the floor, empty the bins

STOCKING IN A SUPERMARKET: set the food department, clean up the shelves
