### Diners in America

Diners are typical American restaurants. The first diners were train wagons converted into cheap (bon marché) restaurants. That's why they are so long, with a long service counter (=comptoir) with stools (tabouret) and very small booths(compartiments) . In diners waiters or waitresses (serveuses) serve typical English food such as hamburgers, French Fries, club sandwiches, harsh brown (galette de pdt) , deep fried chicken, coleslaw (salade de choux) and desserts such as (tel que) pecan pie, cheesecake or ice creams. Customers (clients) come here to have a good time with their family or their friends. You can eat breakfast, lunch or dinner but you can also stop for some hot drink and a snack. (gouter/en cas)
