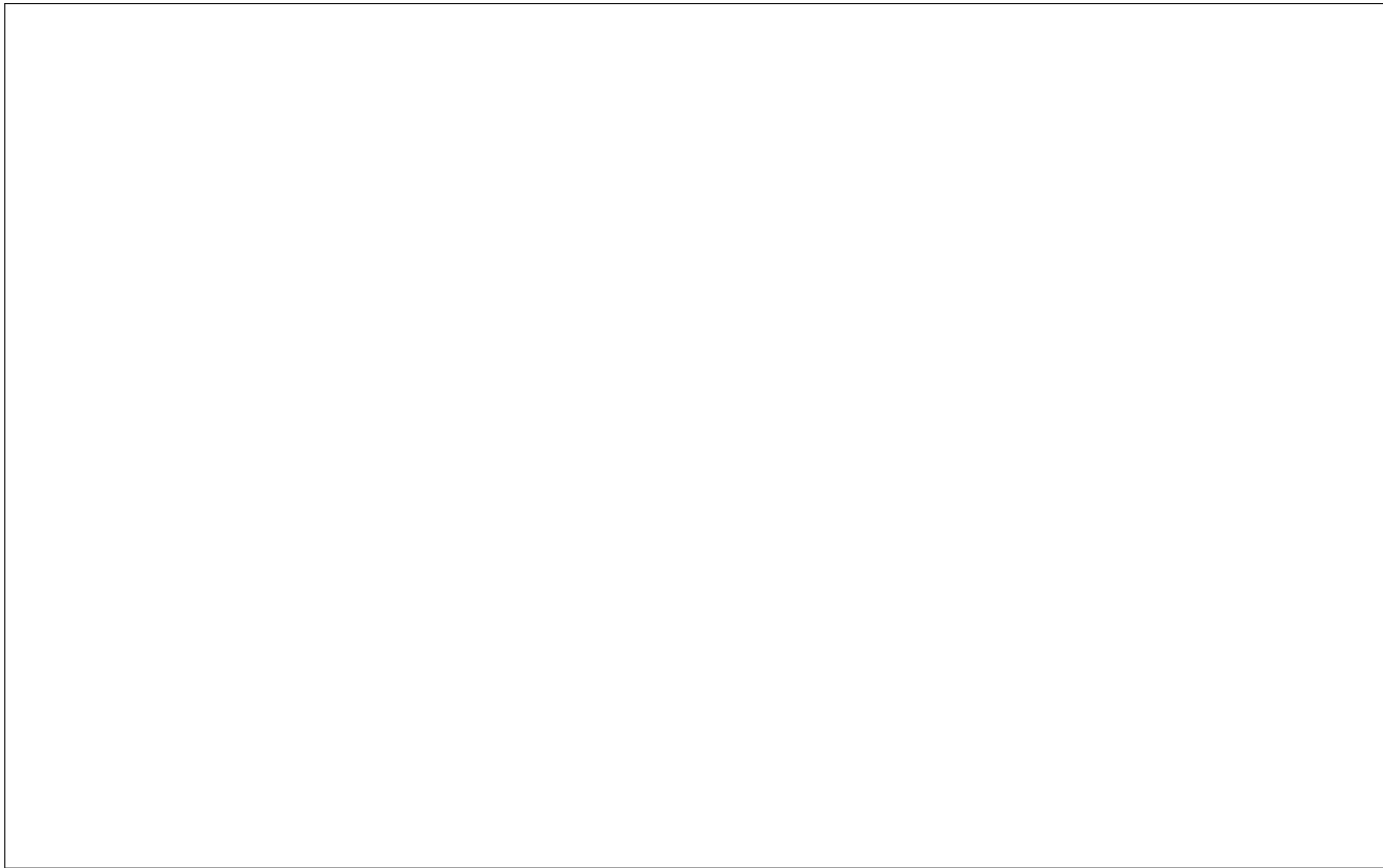

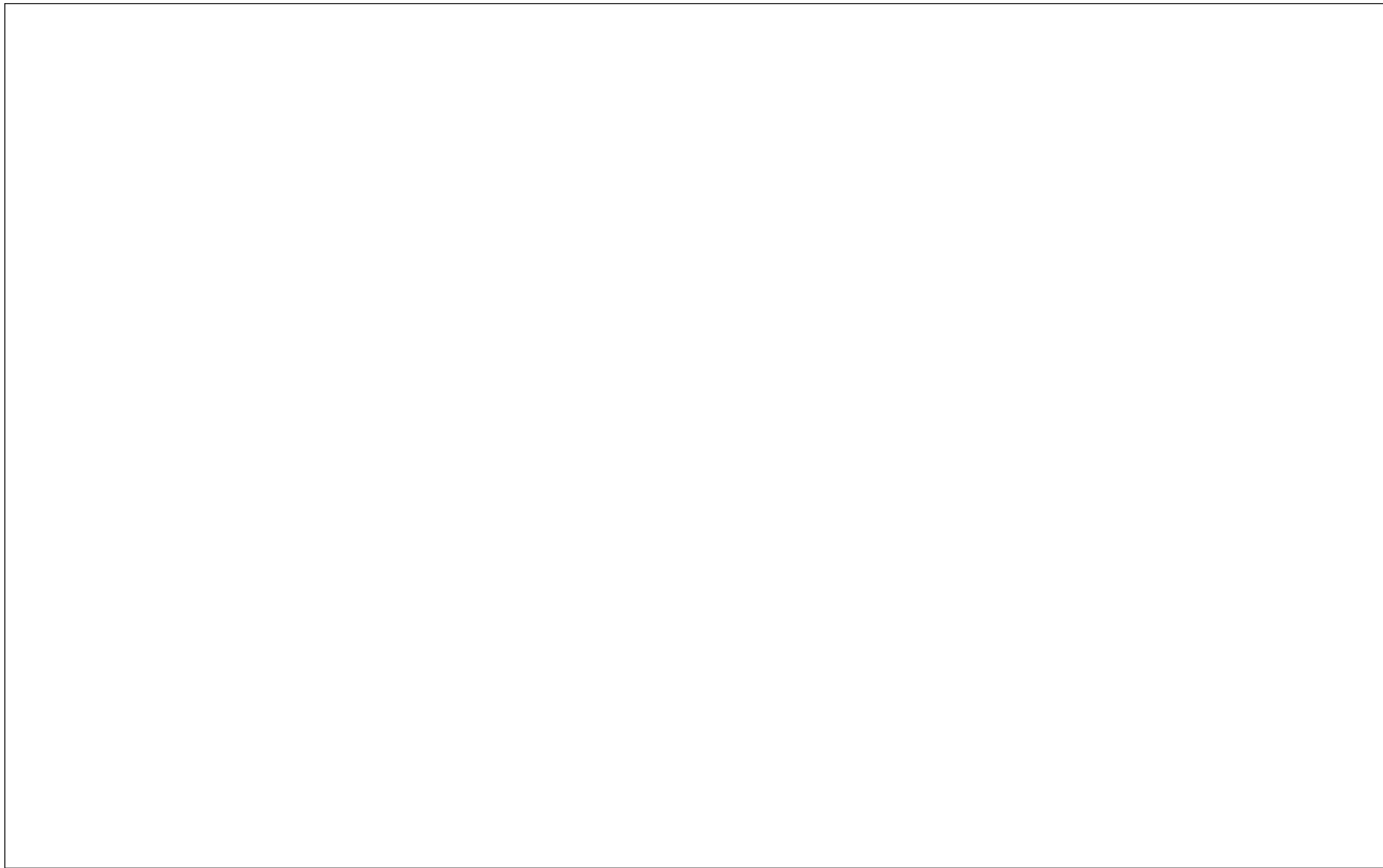

He usually hooves [z] and he often sets [s] the table. He sometimes washes [iz] the laundry and he
takes [s] care of his pet. He is extremely helpful **for (car)** he always does [z] the shopping and he
makes [s] his bed. He clears [z] the table everynight too.

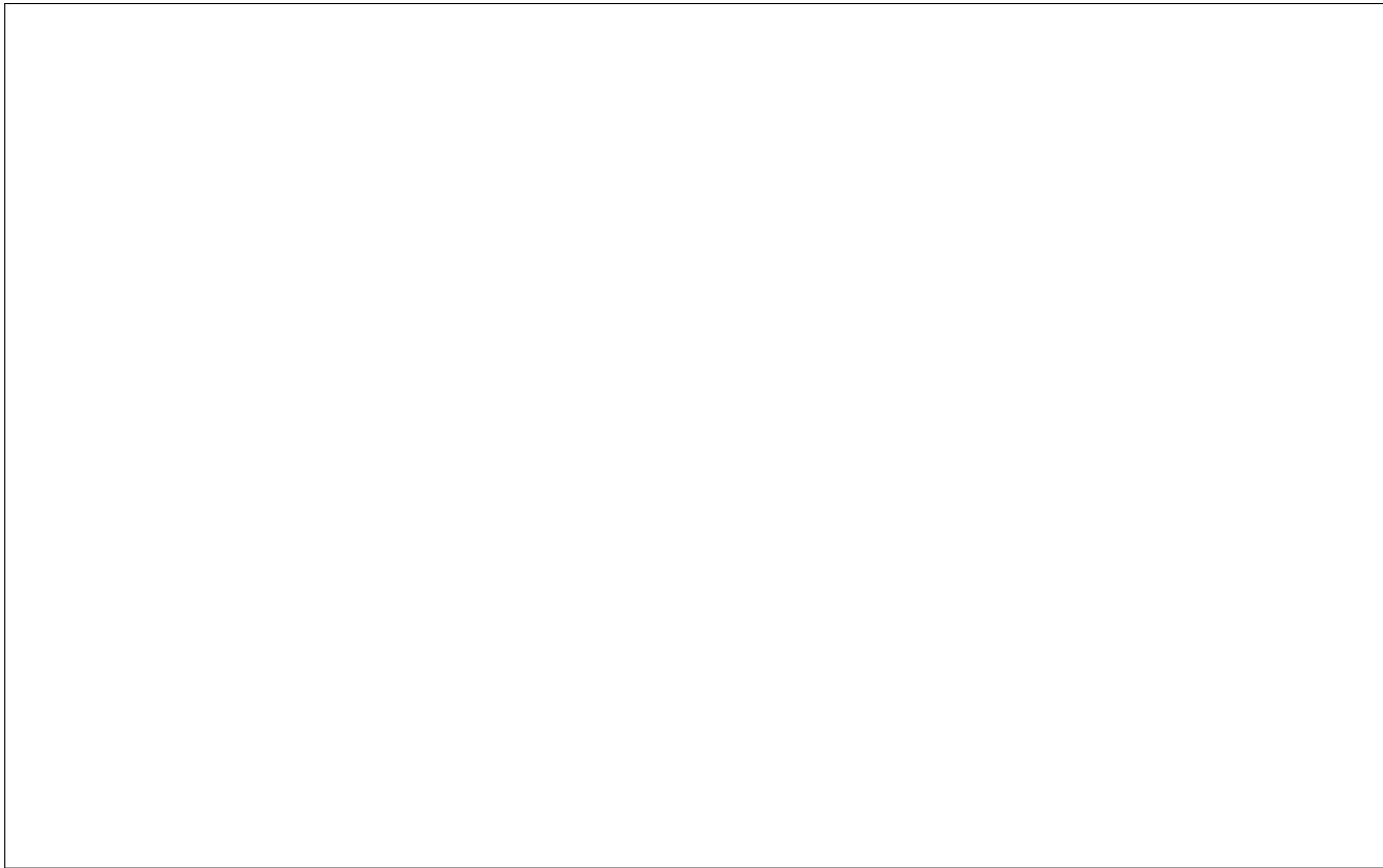
