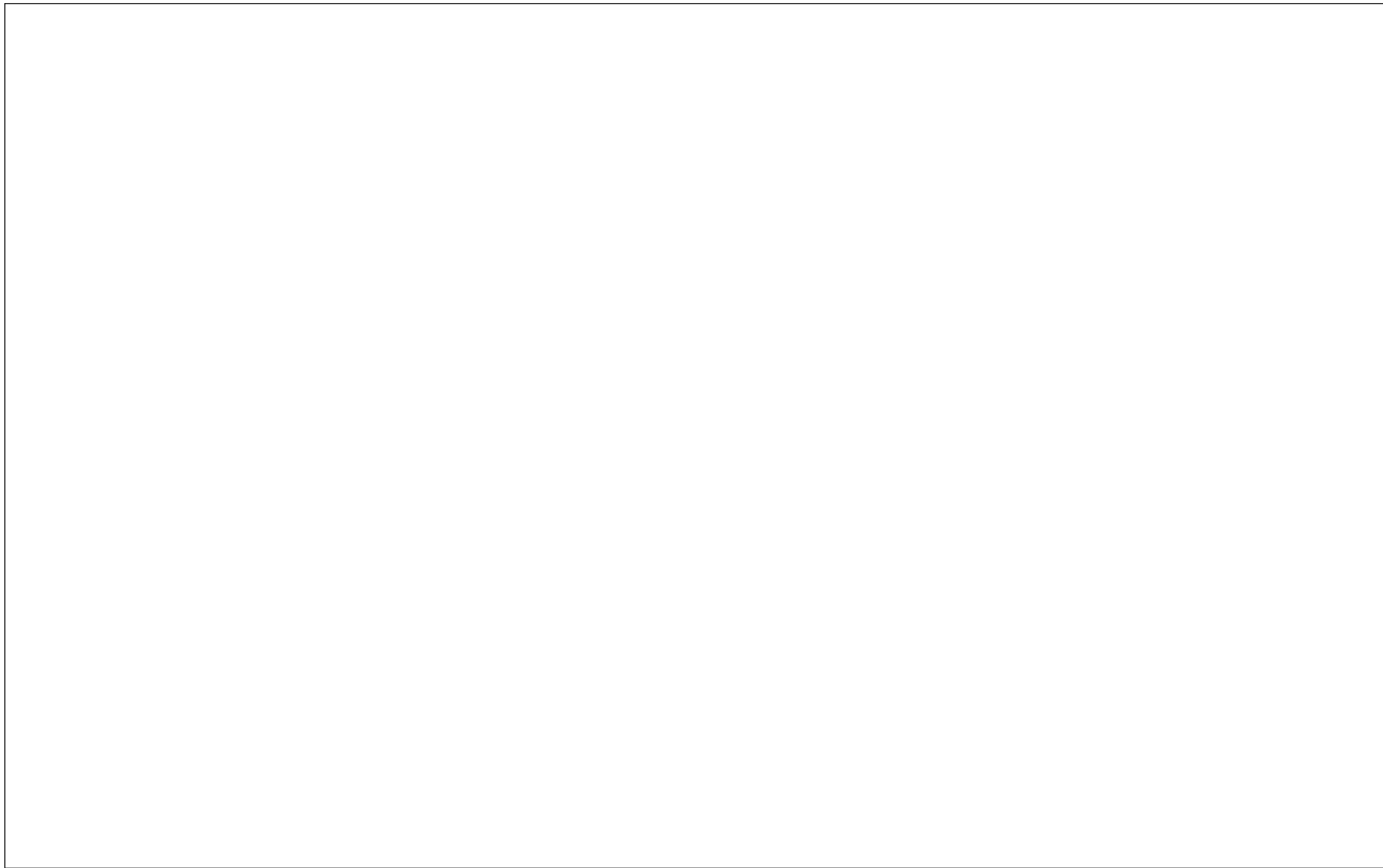
Tom is extremely lazy because he never washes his hands before dinner. He never takes care of his pet and he never clears the table.
